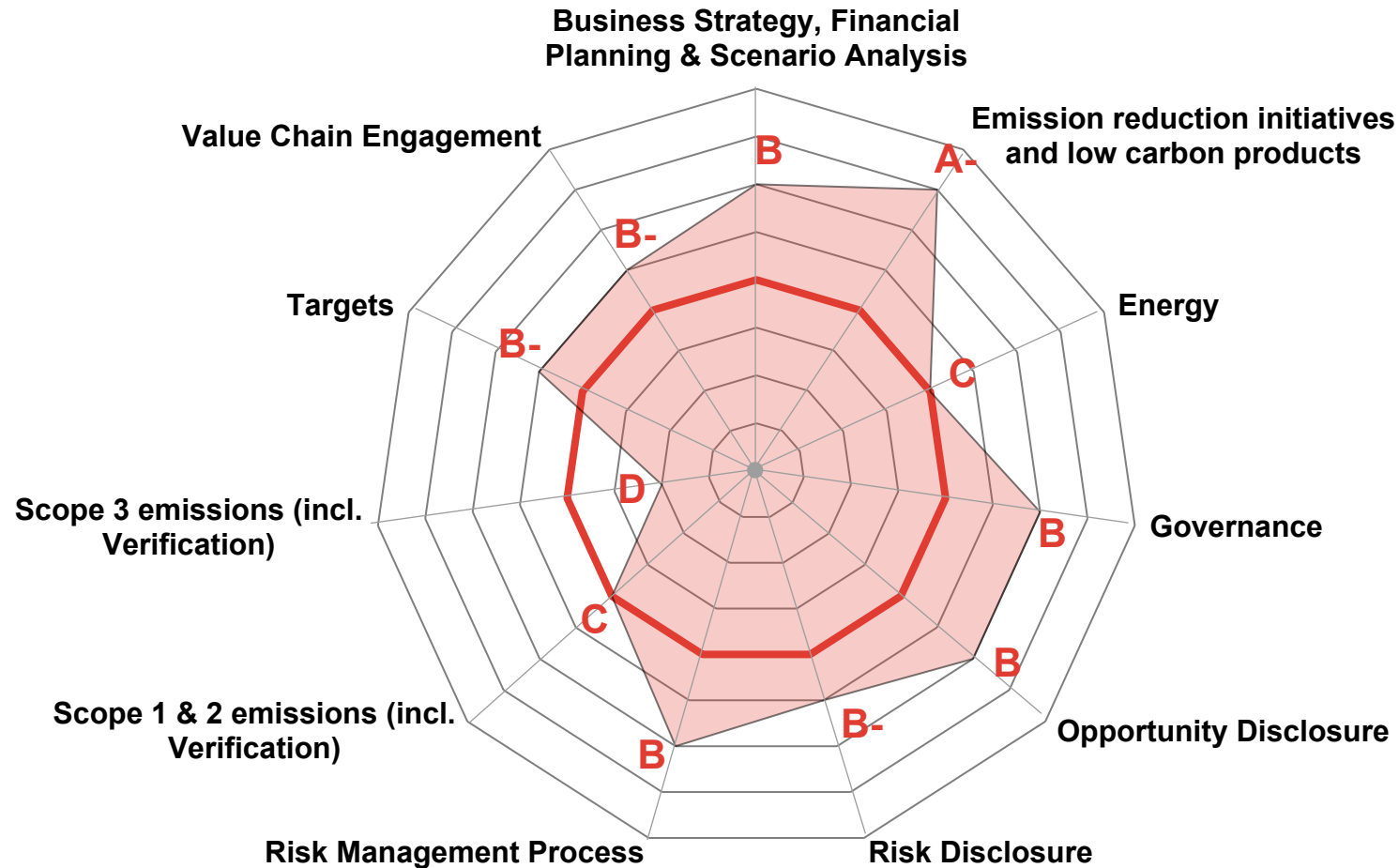

Comments:

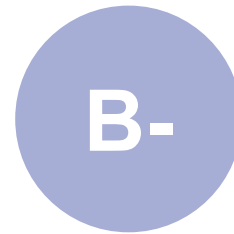
- Acceptable, good results for a first-time disclosure reflecting our Climate strategy and topics

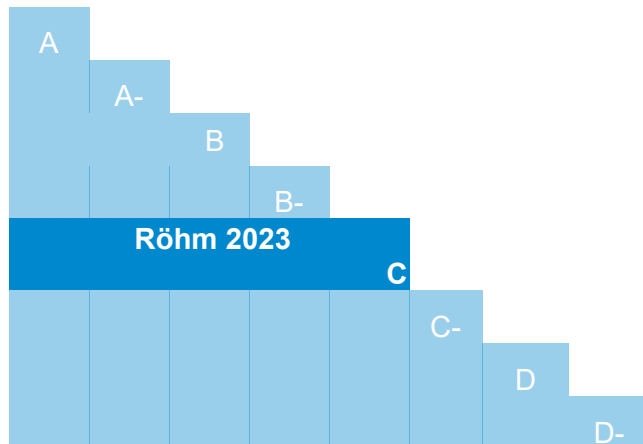
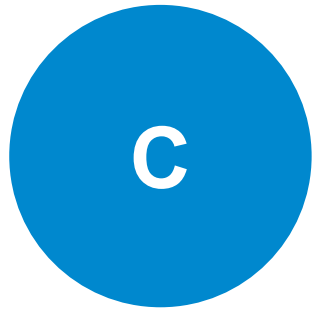


- Very good results for a first-time disclosure reflecting our interaction with suppliers with regards to climate strategy and topics

- On some topics (Governance and Targets) there is some room for improvement

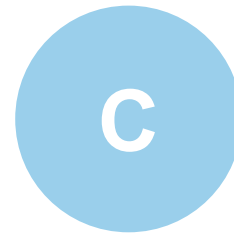
